Other Activities Payable During the Year

Depending on Subjects and Activities that a student selects, there may be other costs payable during the Academic Year:

- TAFE Certificate Courses attract a fee in Year 11 that covers the 2 year course
- If a Student is selected for the Rugby League Confraternity or Netball QISSN teams, then these activities attract a fee that is variable each year depending upon where the carnivals are taking place

- Sporting team uniforms
- Overseas Tours
- Music Camp
- Year 11 Science Camp
- Non-Competitive SECA Activities
- Learning Enhancement and Traction Programs

Enrolment Application and Confirmation Fees

A non-refundable application fee of \$50 (GST inclusive) is payable when an application form is lodged.

When an offer of enrolment is accepted, a non-refundable Confirmation Fee of \$250 (GST exclusive) is payable.

Issuing of Account

The annual fees and levies are billed over four school terms. Invoices will be mailed/emailed at the beginning of each term with payment in full expected by the due date, shown on the account unless payment terms have been entered into.

Methods of Payment

The College offers the following payment methods:

- EFTPOS - Debit and Credit (excluding Diners Club and Amex)
- Bpay
- Cash
- Cheque
- Direct Debit – Instalment scheme payment of Fees and Levies
- BPoint, web-based payment facility
- Centrelink

Overdue Accounts

Accounts that remain unpaid as at the due date, where payment arrangements have not been arranged and agreed to will be pursued as follows:

1. Seven days after the due date a letter will be forwarded requesting payment in full within 7 Days or suitable payment arrangements be made with the College.
2. If the account remains unpaid after Step 1 a second letter is forwarded advising that the account will be referred to the College's Commercial Agents for collection of payment in full is not made within 7 days or suitable arrangements are not made with the College.
3. If the account remains unpaid following step 2 the account will be referred to the Commercial Agents after which all negotiations must be made with the agency. If this step is undertaken, account holders will incur additional costs. Further, continuation of this action may compromise the account holders credit rating and may jeopardise the enrolment of their student(s).

At any time during the collection process account holders may also be approached by the College's accounts staff by email and/or telephone.

Outstanding Debts

Payment of all fees and levies takes precedence over payments for any non-core and extracurricular activities offered by the College, such as major social events, overseas study tours, representative sporting events etc. Families with overdue accounts or with debts outstanding, who seek to make payments for non-core or extracurricular activities, will be informed that such payments will be redirected to the payment of outstanding fees first. Participation in activities such as overseas excursions cannot occur if school fees are in arrears. Exceptions to the above procedure and lifting of restrictions on non-core or extracurricular activities will be at the discretion of the Principal.

Discount for Early Payment

Families who elect to pay the full year's Fees and Levies by Term 1 due date, will receive a discount of 5% on the total account.

Payment Difficulties

Families, who are experiencing difficulties in paying the account, are asked to contact the College as soon as possible. Arrangements can then be made to assist with meeting the commitment. If an arrangement is granted, payments will be made by Centrepay or Direct Debit.

Students exiting after the commencement of a term

No refund will be given on the full term's charges, should a student exit the College after the commencement of the term.
